1. Launch the Registry Editor by opening the run dialog ($+ \mathbb{R}$) and typing:

regedit

- 2. Navigate to :
 Computer\HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersio
 n\Policies\System
- 3. Right-click the System Key in the left pane, expand New from the context menu, and then click DWORD (32-bit) Value.
- 4. Name the new DWORD NoConnectedUser
- 5. Double-click the newly-created DWORD and set its Value Data (Hexadecimal) to either of the following
 - 1. 0 = Allow Microsoft Accounts
 - 2. 1 =Users can't add Microsoft Accounts
 - 3. 3 =Users can't add or log on with Microsoft accounts

By following the steps outlined in this guide, you have successfully updated the registry settings to restrict the use of Microsoft accounts on Windows 11.
